## Answers to FAQs:

**What's the cost?** Early registration is \$38 or \$15 with financial aid. (You're early if you register by March 16 for participants and by February 17 for Staff and Music Team). After that it's \$48 or \$20 with financial aid. 100% financial aid is available.

**Why is it called "TEC"?** TEC is short for *Teens Encounter Christ*.

**Who are the teen leaders?** Kaleb Eddy and Zach DeFosse. They're both from St. Ann's in Windham and they are high school seniors.

**Who can be on Teen Staff?** Any high schooler who has been to TEC in the past and will come to the Team Prep.

**Who can be on Music Team?** You can apply if you like to sing or play an instrument, will come to the Team Prep, and are willing to practice.

**What are the details about the Team Prep?** The Team Prep is for Teen Staff, Adult Staff and Music Team. It is Friday, March 3 at 6:30 (after dinner) until Sunday at 11:30 at Trinity Church in Portland. Bring the same things you bring to the event (except fun or fancy clothes and snack).

**When should adults arrive?** Please come to the Team Prep on March 3-5 and try to arrive on March 24 between 1:30 and 3:00. If you can't arrive until later, please let us know.

**What kinds of things will we do?** Come and experience an event designed and run by your peers. Teens at TEC will meet other teens, be part of interesting discussion groups, engage in enjoyable worship, listen to talks created by other teens, play games, listen to music, and essentially have a great time. It is an excellent way to grow closer to God and others. There'll be great food, new friends and fun.

**What should I bring?** sleeping bag, pillow, mattress (optional), comfortable clothes, fun or fancy clothes for Saturday dinner (optional), toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, shower stuff, towel, swimsuit (optional), some homework (optional), a snack or dessert to contribute (no nuts or peanut butter). Please don't bring money or anything valuable.

**Who can come?** Everyone in high school.
