Youth Camp at Summer Finale Week

August 21-27, Monday afternoon to Sunday morning

(Staff and LLS will meet at St. Thomas Church, 33 Chestnut St., Camden, on Sunday August 20th at 3:00.)

How to get there and what to bring with you!

When: Camp begins on Monday at 3:00 p.m. Camp ends Sunday morning, and we will post the time when we have it.

Where: Camp Bishopswood is located on Lake Megunticook in Hope, Maine. The address is 98 Bishopswood Rd., Hope. The best directions are found at <http://www.bishopswood.org/where-we-are/> as GPS systems frequently misguide travelers over a private, blocked road.

What to bring to camp...:

- Remaining balance if you haven't sent it yet
- **New in 2017! Two Medical Forms unless you sent already; one must be signed by your doctor so please don't wait until the last minute! These are required to be at camp! (*Please see note at bottom with instructions)**
- If you are bringing medicine, bring it in the original medicine bottle with the prescription label. Bring only the correct amount for the week.
- Clothing: shorts, shirts, long pants, underwear, pajamas, warm sweatshirt, jacket, raincoat/poncho, shoes that tie, sandals/flip-flops, socks, bathing suit
- Toiletries: soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, brush/comb
- Other necessities: swim towel that is not used for showering, towels and wash cloths for showering, bedding (sleeping bag or sheets and blankets), pillow, extra warm blanket
- Other things you might enjoy having (optional!): musical instruments, Bible, inexpensive camera, white shirt for craft project, rain boots, laundry bag, flashlight, books, pens/pencils, supplies for sending letters including stamps. High schoolers may want to bring your poems, acts or songs for Coffee House



Things not to bring:

- Food and snacks, because they attract animals in the cabins.
- Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes or T-shirts with negative messages.
- Cell phones (If you bring, please leave with your counselor.)

- Laptops & electronic games
- Valuable items or money

*** There are two Health Forms that must be filled out for a camper to attend Summer Finale Camp. If you have come to BION in the past, you will notice that these are different than in past years. These are the forms that Bishopswood requires for campers.

(1) The Physician's Examination form must be signed by your doctor. In many cases, your camper will not need to see the doctor if he/she has had a check-up in the past year. But the doctor will need to fill out the form.

If your camper does not have any special needs or medicines, and has a current Sports Physical Form from a doctor, you can send us that form instead of the Physician's Examination Form.

(2) The four page Camper Health History Form must be filled out by a parent. If you don't want to answer the Immunization History question on page 2, you can just sign on the parent line on page 2 that you "accept the risk on not being fully immunized."
